

Stream Crossings for Trails



Canada has a system of trails that take us to some beautiful places. They cross streams where, with a bit of luck, you might catch a glimpse of a native brook trout.



Fishculvert has developed small open bottom arches that can be set over a natural stream bed and with little or no excavation, the stream and fish can carry on without disturbance. These arches when covered and backfilled with 300mm of compacted soil can easily carry golf carts, tractors and even fire trucks in the event of an emergency.



The arches are available in two sizes. Small has a span of 1000mm with a rise of 500mm. Large has a 1500mm span and rise of 750mm. Segments are 3658mm long and include bolt on steel footings and stabilizer cables.
